JOB DESCRIPTION

The Middle School Head Volleyball Coach is responsible to work with the Varsity Head Volleyball Coach to:

- Maintain high visibility within the school and the community, developing a positive rapport with students, faculty, parents, community, and the Lions Athletic Association members.
- Communicate high expectations and goals for the team to students, faculty, parents, community, and Lions Athletic Association members.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The major responsibilities of the middle school head coach are listed below as a guide for carrying out assigned duties. Additional responsibilities may be assigned by the Varsity Volleyball Head Coach or the Athletic Director.

- Has an understanding and working knowledge of the rules and regulations of the sport according to any governing body that the sport may use
- Has full responsibility for the overall supervision and duties assignments of assistant coaches of the middle school volleyball program.
- Instructs athletes on proper techniques, game strategies, sportsmanship, and the rules of the sport.
- Plans and organizes practice and games.
- Responsible for keeping the length of practice appropriate and maintaining accurate records and should keep the Athletic Director informed of practice schedules and travel arrangements.
- Be aware of all departure times and return times for his/her team. Inform all players and parents of these times.
- Teach athletes the fundamentals of the sport.
- Is responsible for the general upkeep and protection of equipment under his/her jurisdiction, keeps inventory of the equipment used for middle school volleyball, to be made at the end of each season.
- Is responsible for ensuring that each participant meets the eligibility requirements and proper forms have been turned into the Athletic Department.
- Is responsible for the general health and welfare of students in his/her care and gives appropriate attention to athletes who are injured, ill or otherwise incapacitated.
- Is responsible for the actions, conduct, appearance and behavior of his/her team and assistant coaches whenever they are under his/her jurisdiction.
- Required to abide by the policies established by LCA
- Responsible for communicating all LCA Athletics handbook policies including team rules to athletes and parents.
- Attends all training and staff meetings as needed. Completes a post-season evaluation provided by the Athletic Director
