RESPONSIBILITIES

The major responsibilities of a LCA assistant coach are listed below as a guide for carrying out assigned duties. Additional responsibilities may be assigned by the Varsity Head Coach or the Athletic Director.

- Has an understanding and working knowledge of the rules and regulations of the sport according to any governing body that the sport may use
- Understands the proper administrative chain of command and refers all student/parent requests through the proper channels.
- Maintains discipline and works to increase morale and cooperation within LCA's athletic programs.
- Be present at all practices, games, and while traveling.
- Provide assistance, guidance and safeguards for each participant.
- Understand the policies concerning injuries, medical attention and emergencies.
- Instructs athletes on proper techniques, game strategies, sportsmanship, and the rules of the sport.
- Arrange for issuing and storing of equipment and submits to the head coach an annual inventory and current records concerning the same.
- Coach within the basic framework and philosophy of the Varsity Head Coach or Program Director has set forth.
- Assist the head coach with supervising athletes during practices, competitions, and travel.
- Attend all staff meetings and/or training meetings set by the Head Coach and the Athletic Department.
