RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maintain a state of cleanliness, attractiveness of the buildings and grounds. This includes, but is not limited to, the daily, weekly, and monthly requirements to maintain the expected state such as touch up paint, daily cleaning, maintenance of carpets and flooring, etc.
- Perform general maintenance work, as assigned, which may include painting, furniture repairs, drywall repairs, ceiling tiles, carpeting, floor tiles, replacement of lamps, ballasts, maintaining and/or replacing door hardware, etc.
- Assist with general construction projects, which may include constructing fencing (wood & chain link), shade structures, shelving, roofs etc., in a safe manner using various hand and power tools.
- Perform general plumbing work which may include inspecting/replacing plumbing fixtures, removing blockages to restroom/kitchen facilities & inspecting/repairing leaks.
- Troubleshoot and repair electrical issues. Replace bulbs and ballasts as needed.
- Ensure trash is picked up around campus.
- Install equipment in each classroom prior to the first day of preplanning.
